Re: COVID-19 Update

Since my update last Thursday, we had two associates test positive. They are quarantined at home. No residents tested positive during this period.

Outbreak testing goes for 14 days since the last positive person. Both of the associates mentioned above work in Parkside and thus outbreak testing will continue for the next 10 days. We will conduct another round of testing in Parkside this week and next. In the meantime, we will reevaluate should any Parkside resident or associate tests positive.

Community transmission of COVID19 remains high (Red) in Ohio. With the new BA.5 subvariant and already high rates of transmission we expect new cases to increase and are therefore diligent to protect our residents and associates. Our protocols include routine and outbreak testing, screening of associates, health care providers and visitors upon entry along with the use of appropriate PPE. In Parkside face masks are **Strongly Recommended** for residents and required for visitors. In Barnes Center we require face masks and face shields for associates, health care providers and visitors.

We will continue to monitor the testing and communicate any changes as they occur.
