Re: COVID-19 Update

On Monday a nurse practitioner reported that they tested positive with COVID. They had visited these three residents last Thursday. Two rounds of focused testing were completed on these three residents with all being negative. Other routine testing of associates did not reveal any other positive cases. We will reevaluate the testing schedule in each area should any resident or associate test positive.

Community transmission of COVID19 remains high (Red) in Ohio yet is continuing a downward decline over the last five weeks. Our protocols include routine and outbreak testing, screening of associates, health care providers and visitors upon entry along with the use of appropriate PPE. In Parkside face masks are **Recommended** for residents and required for visitors. In Barnes Center we require face masks and face shields for associates, health care providers and visitors.

We will continue to monitor the testing and communicate any changes as they occur.
