RE: COVID INFECTIVITY RATES

Both Franklin and Fairfield Counties are now the “red” category in the CMS color-coding system. This means several things **for our nursing homes** on each campus:

- 1) Face shields and fresh masks will be given to anyone entering the nursing home. Everyone entering the nursing home must wear a face shield and a face mask.
- 2) No one may use the nursing homes as a pass way to other areas.
- 3) The nursing home resident vaccine rate will be monitored daily based on census. At 70% or less, visitation in the nursing home will be stopped.
- 4) Unvaccinated residents in isolation for fourteen (14) days in the nursing homes cannot have visitors during that time except for compassionate care visits.
- 5) Visitors must wear face shields and masks while visiting residents in the nursing homes (and, of course, residents wear face masks during visits).
- 6) Residents who share a room in the nursing home may not have “in-room” visits.

**All** are encouraged to be vigilant in the wearing of masks anywhere on our campuses. I thank you for your patience and understanding.

Visits in other levels of care (independent, assisted, and memory care) will continue unless we have an “outbreak,” which is considered one positive case. You will, of course, be notified should that happen.
