RE: GOVERNOR DEWINE'S PARTIAL RESCISSION OF
ORDERS ABOUT VISITATION ON OUR CAMPUSES

Good news! Governor DeWine has rescinded portions of his order affecting our communities as follows, effective immediately:

1. Visits no longer need to be scheduled on our campuses;
2. There is no limit on the number of visitors at a time on our campuses;
3. Visitors no longer need to be escorted to their visits (which was required in some circumstances/areas).

We ask all visitors to continue to use our Accushield machines upon visiting to answer the brief health screen questionnaire and have their temperatures taken. We ask everyone (for the time being) to wear a mask in common areas of our campuses, as the rules on this have not changed. Fully vaccinated people may meet in small groups with other fully vaccinated people without masks. Still, we do urge caution at this time, as the news is replete with cases of the Delta variant (and others). If we get a positive case, the area affected will need to be temporarily shut down for visitation. We do NOT want to have anyone become infected when simple precautions are working so well, and we appreciate your patience and understanding with this.
