Re: COVID-19 Update

Since last Thursday we have had one Parkside resident, and three associates (two in Barnes, and one in Bishop Place) test positive. They all have been quarantined per policy.

Barnes, Bishop Place and Parkside are all conducting outbreak testing every several days until we reach fourteen days with no new positive cases in that area.

Community transmission of COVID remains high (Red) in Ohio and we do expect cases. To capture any transmission early our protocols include routine and outbreak testing, screening associates, health care providers and visitors upon entry along with the use of appropriate PPE. In Parkside face masks are **Recommended** for residents and required for visitors. In Bishop Place, English Garden, and the Barnes Center we require face masks and face shields for associates, health care providers and visitors.

We will continue to monitor the testing and communicate any changes as they occur.
